

What is a Career Plan?

A career plan is a plan that helps you determine your skills and interests, what career best suits your talents, and what skills and training you need for your chosen career.

Career planning is essential to achieving success in your chosen career. Whether you are aiming to be a Accounts Assistant in a small business or the Finance Director of a national or multi-national corporation, you must know in which direction you are headed and what is required of you to achieve your goal.

- Plan to reach career goal: (objectives)
- Time-scales
